Legislator Lorigo announces Boys and Girls Clubs to receive \$25,000

(ELMA/AURORA/HOLLAND, NY) – Erie County Legislator Joseph C. Lorigo announces that the Elma, Marilla, Wales (EMW) Boys and Girls Club, the East Aurora Boys and Girls Club, and the Boys & Girls Club of Holland will receive program funding in the 2018 Erie County budget. The Legislature approved a total of \$25,000 at the Dec. 7, 2017 annual budget meeting to support the club’s mission of providing quality development services to the towns’ young people.

“These Boys and Girls Clubs are a valuable part of our communities, and provide a tremendous amount of support for our young people and families. I have secured funding for the past several years for the clubs in my district and am always impressed with the programming developed as a result.
